

Monday Nov 15 → God, You're so good to me ⊬

Psalm 106:1 - "Praise the Lord! O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for His steadfast love endures forever!"

As we launch into a season of "giving thanks" let's spend some time thinking about God's goodness and mercy towards us. We're going use the song we're singing on Sunday mornings this month to celebrate how good God is in rescuing sinners. Let's dive in.

Tuesday Nov 16 → I am #blessed .←

Ephesians 1:3 - "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in Christ in the heavenly places."

There is nothing that you lack that God has not given to you. Read the remainder of the chapter and consider all that God has blessed you with. Thank God for all these spiritual blessings we have becasue of the work of Christ.

Wednesday Nov 17 → I am called ←

1 Corinthians 1:9 - "God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord."

Think about our faithful God calling you into fellowship with Jesus. What does this envision? Give thanks to God for calling you into such an intimate, secure fellowship.

Thursday Nov 18 → I am healed ←

Isaiah 53:5 - "He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities, upon Him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with His wounds we are healed."

Every aspect of our brokenness and rebellion, God has reconciled and redeemed. Thank God for the complete healing of our souls and uniting us to the work of Christ.

Friday Nov 19 → I am whole ←

Galatians 2:20 - "I have been crucified with Christ and it is no longer I who live but Christ who lives in me, and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of loved me and gave Himself for me."

What was your life like before Jesus? Think about all the ways He has brought wholeness into your life. Thank God for His life changing salvation brought to us through Jesus.

Saturday Nov 20 → I am saved ←

Ephesians 2:8-9 - "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing, it is the gift of God, not a result of works so that no one may boast."

God has delivered us from our sin and shame and we reap these benefits through faith. Thank God that He does not require the works of religion to save us from the wrath to come. He has freely given to us our salvation.

Sunday Nov 21 → I am highly favored ←

Psalm 30:5 - "For His anger is but for a moment, and His favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning."

Our lives are marked by suffering, weakness, weeping, and often it seems like the dark night of our souls won't lift. But God's favor is eternal. Thank God for the favor He's put over your soul and anticipate resting in this for eternity.

Monday Nov 22 → I am anointed .←

2 Corinthians 1:21-22 - "And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee."

God has crowned our lives with His favor and honor, anointing us with the oil of gladness as we experience all kinds of goodness flowing from Christ. Thank Him for how He has secured our standing through Jesus.

Tuesday Nov 23 → I am filled with Your power 1←

Acts 1:8 - "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Jesus promised to send us a Helper and when we believe, the Spirit comes upon us to do that which we could never dare to do on our own. Thank God for the power He's filled you with to love Him and others through the Holy Spirit.

Wednesday Nov 24 → I am for God's glory ←

Psalm 106:8 - "Yet God saved them for His name's sake, that He might make known His mighty power."

In the Bible, so much of what God is doing to rescue people like us is done to make His fame spread over the whole world. As you continue to think of God's goodness in this season, thank Him for acting for your good and what brings Him glory.

Thanksgiving Day → The Face of Goodness ← Jesus Christ our Lord

John 1:14 - "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth."

Think about how good God is. And, His goodness has a face - Jesus came to earth to live, die, rise, and ascend to heaven for us. As we anticipate this upcoming season of Advent, let's thank God for His best gift: Jesus Christ our Lord.
