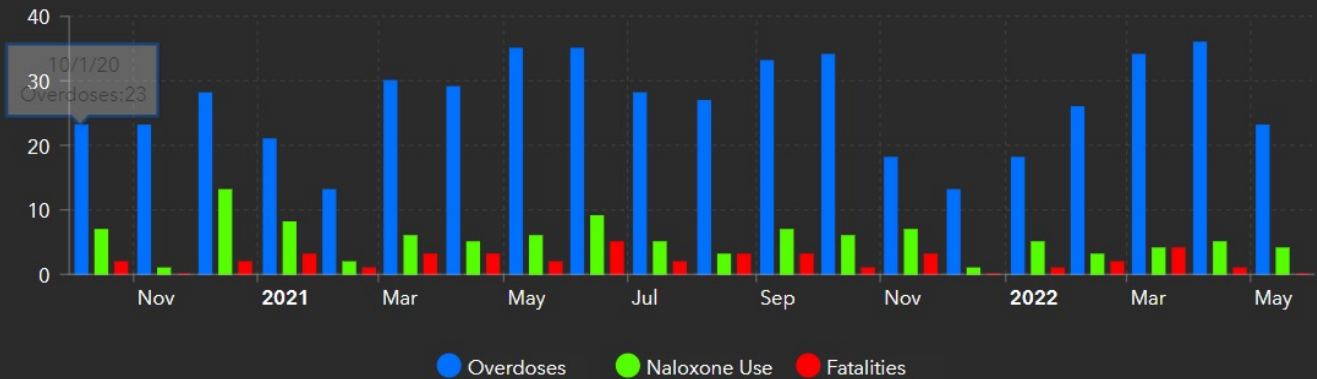

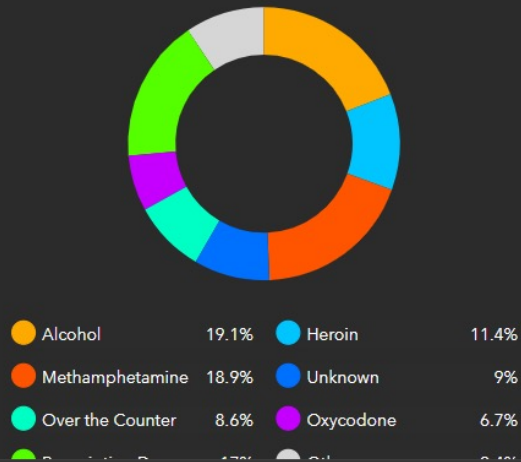

Drug Overdoses by Month

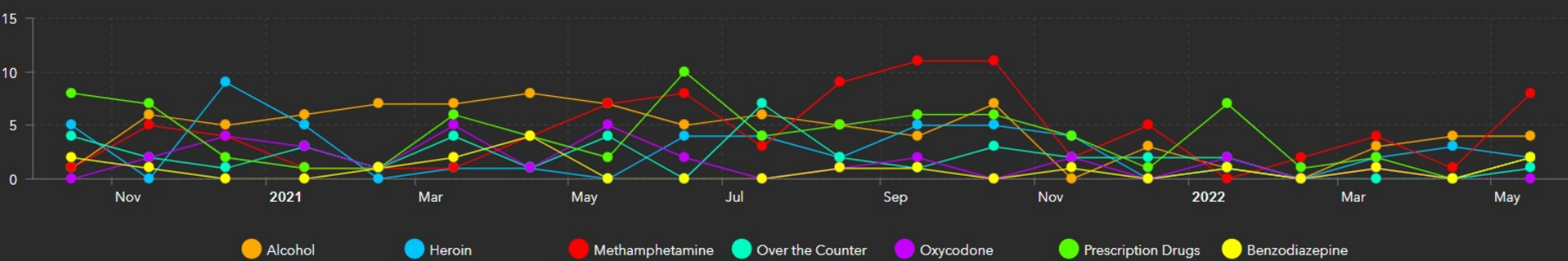

Fentanyl

- ◇ Synthetic opioid typically used to treat patients with chronic severe pain or severe pain following surgery.
- ◇ Fentanyl is a Schedule II controlled substance that is similar to morphine but about 100 times more potent.
- ◇ Now being illicitly manufactured making it even more unsafe as its unregulated and being mixed with other substances.



Whether intentional or not,
mixing drugs is never safe
because the effects from
combining drugs are often
stronger, more unpredictable,
and even deadly.

dose.

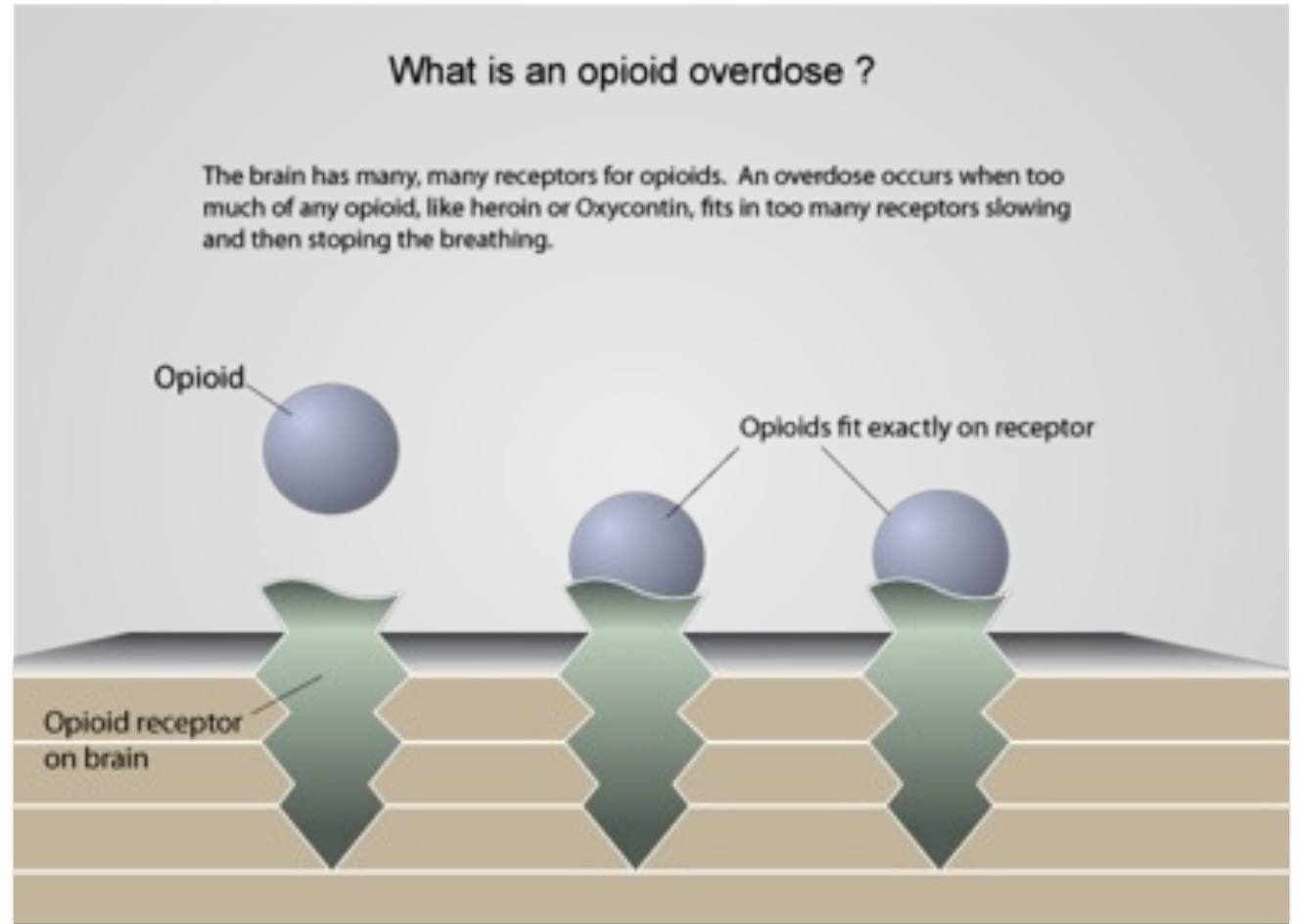


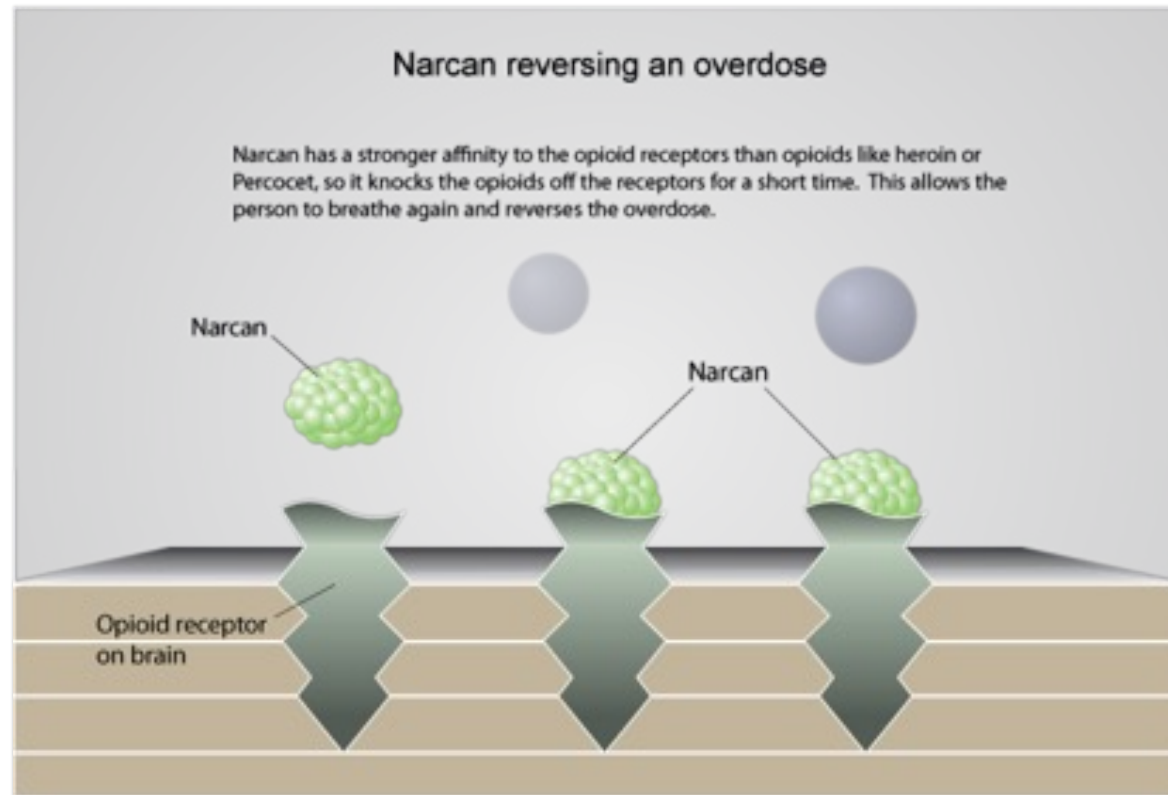
Authentic oxycodone M30 tablets
